  - BFC looking to add flow meters, but doesn't want to duplicate work
  - CU CIRES said they are potentially willing to help us. 2 points at outlet, and 1 meter at inlet. Parks and Open space may be able to monitor for us.
  - Looking to monitor stream flow, temps, dissolved oxygen....James said he knew of a kit that is available to monitor it all
  - Entomology Data monitored thru River Watch potentially – will need volunteers, CU said may be interested in Environmental Studies Program
  - Rob motioned to spend up to \$1000 for the entire metering project for South Boulder Creek. James seconded the motion. Vote Approved.
  - Environmental Pool thought to be an easy way to get Lafayette and Boulder together to add water during low flow, is not so easy....Rob and Rich reaching out to figure out this complicated topic.
