### 1-31-2018 Meeting

- Audit committee met, reviewed and approved the finances for 2017
- SBC and Denver water update – modification on the community ditch is needed in order to improve fish passage. Pre-requisite to meeting with Denver water is that the environmental pool releasing water downstream has engineering issues – divergent gates need to be updated. Expected 5-7 years complete, 3-5 years to practice. Boulder Open space has \$200k available to spend for a project. Lafayette has \$200k.

- Louisville Middle School Fly Fishing Club looking for an aquatic person to talk about something and be interactive between March 14<sup>th</sup> and May 9<sup>th</sup> 4-5pm

- Neon is a monitoring company that said they would head up the water monitoring for South Boulder creek per James.
- Rob suggested that we make a goal to have stream monitoring in place for South Boulder Creek by June.
